R - Relevance - Is the info appropriate for your use? To whom is the website directed (audience)

A - Author - Is the author identified? People want credit for good work. Who is the publisher? What are the author's credentials for this topic?

A - Accuracy - Is the info accurate? Has the article been evaluated? Do others confirm the info? Does it cite sources?

P - Purpose - What was the purpose for publishing this website/article? Facts or opinions?
